ACADEMIC CALENDAR

The school's academic session starts in March and ends in March of the following year. There are two terms, one which ends in September and the other in March. During each term there are two rounds of Unit Assessments for each subject and an end of term exam. Report cards are issued twice in a year and continuous reports are given to the parents regarding the student's progress through personal meetings or email communication.

EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITIES/STUDENT OPPORTUNITIES

The school has a well-defined programme for extra-curricular activities with students taking active part in various cultural and sports conventions. All activities including sports, music, theatre, art and craft, debating etc. culminate with house competitions between the four houses namely Curie, Mandela, Terasa and Raman. Students of our school participated in the events like; Macbeth competition- British Council, Astronomy quiz, Poetry competition on Women Empowerment conducted by Netherland Embassy, ECOM Forum, Hour of Code and Odyssey of Mind competition, Wharton High School Investment competition, Amity International Modern United Nations (AIMUN) at Singapore & Dubai in 2018. Students participated in an interactive session titled 'Persuasive marketing for social cause' conducted by Cardiff Business School (U.K). Students attended Ted Talk by Tanmay Bakshi – World's youngest IBM Watson Coder.

Every year, Amity Global School organizes a science colloquium for students in the age group of 14-15yrs. AGSN played host to delegations from Swiss schools, comprising of both students and educators. Our school is also registered as a member of The International Award for Young People (IAYP). In 2018, School conducted a week long exchange programme, where a teacher from Germany conducted interactive sessions with the students. The school hosted Inter Amity Start Up workshop and competition conducted by experts from Germany. In 2018 students designed & conducted plastic consumption survey in their neighborhood and came up with alternative solutions.
